Re: Year 12 – The Museum of Classical Archaeology – Thursday 6th June 2024

As part of your son/daughter's A Level Classics course, students have the opportunity to visit the Museum of Classical Archaeology in Cambridge. This museum displays over 450 casts of some of the best known and most important examples of classical sculpture, many of which are studied as part of the Greek Art A-level module.

The trip will run on Thursday 6th June, with students leaving at 9:45am to travel by minibus into Cambridge. We will be dropped off directly outside the museum at approximately 11:15am and spend time visiting the gallery. The trip will conclude in Cambridge at approximately 2pm. After this, we will return to school on the minibus, aiming to be back by 3:30pm (depending on traffic).

Students need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, and they may like to bring a small amount of spending money to purchase an ice cream. Bags are allowed in the museum, but they must be placed on a storage rack during the visit.

The cost of the trip is £6.00. Payments will need to be made online using the School Gateway website (see details attached), as soon as possible. Please also provide EMERGENCY CONTACT details and any MEDICAL issues (if applicable) at this time.
